The purpose of the policy is to provide guidelines for usage of Parish noticeboards and the material displayed within these.

The objective of the policy is to facilitate the provision of community information of interest to the residents and visitors of the Parish of Waldridge.

The noticeboards are the property of Waldridge Parish Council. These are currently located at Fenton Close, Poplar Street, the Millennium Green and on the C11 next to the entrance to Falstone Drive.

The Parish Council has the right to deny the posting of any information that does not adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Parish Council notices take precedent over any other notices.
2. Priority is then given to events or organisations which are local Parish charities and non-profit making events. The Clerk has authority to display notices on the notice boards. Display of Community Information Notices will only take place if there is space available and will be displayed at the Clerk's discretion.
3. No party-political notices or advertisements are permitted.
4. The Council continues to remove unauthorised notices from its property.
